

CNAA Privacy Statement

The new General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) came into force on 25th May 2018. When you completed your application form to become a member of CNAA you agreed to certain data being held by CNAA. We want to confirm what data we hold about you and how we use it.

For the purpose of sending you the Newsletter, information about upcoming events and contacting you about issues affecting the allotments we hold your name address and email address. For use only in emergencies we also hold your telephone number.

We will share your data only with organisations to which CNAA has a formal affiliation in order to deliver its stated services to members. Currently we provide details of members names, postal addresses and email addresses to comply with the rules of the National Allotment Society (NAS) to which CNAA is affiliated. You can withdraw your consent at any time but as release of data to NAS is a condition of 2019 CNAA membership you will not be able to remain a member of CNAA.

We do not share with or release your data to any other organisation or use it for any other purpose.

We will remove your details from our lists once you cease to be a member or three months after your membership has lapsed and you have received a reminder from CNAA that membership fees are due.
